DESCRIPTION

The Alexandra is a traditional community pub nestled in the heart of Darwen, a historic market town in Lancashire, England. Well-connected by road and rail, Darwen offers easy access via the A666, linking it to Blackburn and Bolton, and is served by direct trains to Manchester Victoria, Clitheroe, and surrounding towns. This makes The Alexandra not only a beloved local pub but also a welcoming stop for visitors exploring this historic and accessible part of Lancashire.

The pub offers a unique and versatile layout, centred around a central servery bar that seamlessly serves both the main bar and lounge areas. This design ensures smooth, efficient service throughout the venue. The lounge room provides a relaxed and welcoming atmosphere, featuring a comfortable mix of fixed bench seating and low-level chairs, complemented by a blend of carpeted and tiled flooring. Soft furnishings add a homely touch, while a small raised area with an open fire enhances the cosy, inviting feel perfect for dining or unwinding with friends. Entertainment is well-catered for with a pool table, multiple TVs showing live sports, and a dedicated DJ area equipped for live music, karaoke, and quiz nights. The main bar area offers a more vibrant, social setting, with hardwood flooring, high bar stools, and bench seating around the windows. The space is designed for active engagement, featuring dartboards, a second pool table, and live sports screens, making it a lively games room atmosphere.
