DESCRIPTION

The Old Hop Pole is a traditional, characterful public house situated close to the town centre, it is one of West Bromwich's longest-established pubs and is particularly well known among supporters of West Bromwich Albion Football Club. The Old Hop Pole primarily serves a local community customer base, attracting a mix of long-standing residents, working professionals and retired patrons. Its reputation as a traditional ale house and community pub makes it particularly popular with mature customers who appreciate real ale and a classic pub atmosphere. On match days, the demographic broadens considerably, drawing football supporters from across the Black Country and West Midlands region. The pub's status as a recognised meeting point for Albion fans contributes significantly to its trade and identity. There are plenty of transport links around the pub with a tram stop just a 5 minutes walk away and there are plenty of bus routes in and out of the area. For further afield the M5 is just over one mile away making it easily accessible by car.

Pub Layout

The pub retains much of its traditional charm, featuring a welcoming front bar, cosy lounge areas separated by arches and partition walls, and an attractive coal stove that adds to its warm atmosphere. It has built a reputation as a genuine community pub, offering a friendly environment for both regular customers and visitors. Externally there is an enclosed courtyard which has benches for outdoor drinking and a smoking area.

TRADING STYLE

The Old Hop Pole is a well-established pub, currently it operates as a traditional wet-led community public house, there are the usual bar snacks available with a back bar cob offer. With its football heritage being the key to the trade in the Old Hop Pole it is important to maintain this along with the real ale drinkers.

The refurbishment will be refined and personalised once a long-term licensee is secured, incorporating their vision for the look and feel of the business.



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
