DESCRIPTION

The Royal Oak is an attractive and successful village pub located in Warboys, just a 15-minute drive north-east of Huntingdon. The pub is well positioned for access to the surrounding towns and villages, with good road links to Huntingdon and the A1, providing convenient connections to Peterborough, Cambridge and the wider area. The pub is a characterful two-room property, retaining many of its traditional features including exposed beams and a welcoming log fire. Warboys is a well-established and thriving village with a population of more than 4,000 and a strong range of local amenities, including a primary school, GP surgery, post office, village shop, library, playing fields and a sports and social club. This provides the Royal Oak with a strong local customer base and an excellent opportunity for a licensee to become an active part of the village community and build on the pub's existing success.

Pub Layout

Upon entering The Royal Oak, customers are welcomed into a traditional and inviting bar area, where exposed beams and a charming log fire create a warm, characterful atmosphere. The layout has been thoughtfully designed, with a commercial kitchen and ground-floor cellar conveniently located directly behind the bar, ensuring an efficient and practical operating environment. The pub offers two distinct trading areas, providing excellent flexibility for both food-led and wet-led operations. These adaptable spaces can be tailored to suit the needs of the business, whether for casual dining, drinks, or community-focused events. The dedicated dining area accommodates approximately 24 covers and offers a comfortable setting that is both cosy and spacious. A feature fireplace enhances the welcoming ambience, making it an attractive space for customers throughout the year. Externally, The Royal Oak benefits from a substantial gravelled car park to the front of the property, providing convenient customer parking. At the front of the pub, the generously sized beer garden provides seating for over 50 guests and presents a fantastic opportunity to maximise trade during the warmer months. The outdoor space is equally well suited to al fresco dining, social gatherings, live entertainment, and community events, helping to drive year-round customer engagement.

TRADING STYLE

The Royal Oak is a well-established community pub with a strong and loyal local following, supported by a busy drinking trade and a traditional food offer. The pub plays an active role within the village, with regular events helping to maintain a strong connection with the local community. Live music is held every Saturday and the popular weekly quiz takes place each Tuesday, alongside a range of other events throughout the year. The pub also hosts an annual festival each July, which is a well-supported event and provides an excellent opportunity to attract both regular customers and visitors to the area. The pub also benefits from a well-supported cask ale range, which is an important part of its existing offer and appeals to its established customer base. The business also benefits from a particularly strong income from gaming machines, providing an additional and valuable revenue stream alongside the core wet and food trade. There is a good opportunity for a new licensee to build on this established base, while developing the food, drink and events offer further to increase sales and strengthen the pub's position within the local community.
